An effective command and Lesson Plans The Control of Nature system must account for the characteristics and limits of human nature and at the same time exploit and enhance uniquely human skills. There are any number of other factors that might affect classroom engagement: different teachers might be more skilled at eliciting student engagement; some topics are more engaging than others; hands-on lessons might be more engaging than lecture-based lessons; one set of students might be more attentive than another; a smaller class might be more engaged than one with more students; one classroom might be exposed to more distractions than another for example, opening onto a particularly noisy hallway ; engagement might peak at the beginning of the school year and flag as the year wore on; and students might find it easier to focus on schoolwork in the morning than the afternoon.
